





# Level 2 Award in Principles of Risk Assessment RQF and Workshop

## Introduction

Health and safety legislation demands that employers make a suitable and sufficient assessment of:

- The risks to the health and safety of his employees to which they are exposed whilst they are at work
- The risks to the health and safety of persons not in his employment.

Those carrying out risk assessments must be competent to do so and all assessments must be documented if there are five or more employees in the company.
